## 2016 WINTER PRE-DANCE PROGRAM

Welcome *Spotlight Dancers* to the Winter 2016 session of the Pre-Dance program. Our goal is to introduce dance to your child while promoting self-esteem and peer interaction.

**Class Session:** The class session will run for 12 weeks. The price for the session is \$103 for one class or \$160 for two classes, which includes a certificate and small headpiece/costume.

**Attire:** Girls are required to wear leotards and tights, and pink leather ballet shoes (no satin ballet slippers), and tan tap shoes. Girls may wear a skirt over the leotard if the student will not be distracted by it. Boys are required to wear a t-shirt and dance pants or sweat pants, black ballet shoes, and black tap shoes. Please write your child's name in all shoes to prevent mix-ups.

**Restroom:** Please make sure your child has used the restroom before class. The instructors and helpers can only escort the children to the restroom. They are not permitted to assist in any way inside the restroom. If your child needs help in the restroom please remain in the building.

**Scheduled Breaks:** There will be no dance classes Tuesday, March 22nd through Saturday March 26th for Spring break.

**Inclement Weather:** We will NOT follow the Prince William County School System for weather related closings this year. In the event dance classes have to be cancelled the last week of dance classes will be extended.

**Watch Days:** Parents may watch the students in the dance room during the first week of class. All other times you may watch the dance classes through the observation window. This window is to be shared with all parents and visitors. Please try not to communicate with your dancer through the window. At the last scheduled class, students will demonstrate what they have learned throughout the session at a small recital held in the classroom during their regularly scheduled class time.
